« Harmonious and silky with refined tannins. Layered with perfume and airy exotic spices. Long and subtle. » 18/20

White Wine

« Rich apricot nose, exuberant and spicy. Broad, juicy, and concentrated, with energy and punch, and plenty of extract ; excellent length. » 17.5/20

Red Wine

« Spicy, peppery, cherry nose. Concentrated with robust tannins behind the sweet fruit. Intense and persistent. » 17/20
