2007 PISONI VINEYARD – Santa Lucia Highlands Pinot Noir:
“Intense and structured, this beautifully crafted red offers a core of blackberry, raspberry and blueberry flavors. Full-bodied, pleasantly chewy and gutsy, gaining depth and momentum and finishing with a strong, assertive, flavorful finish.”

2007 CHENOWETH RANCH – Russian River Valley Pinot Noir:
“Intense, rich, ripe and vibrant, showing loads of blackberry, wild berry and raspberry fruit, with floral and spicy scents. Full-bodied, balanced, deep and persistent, ending with firm tannins.”

2007 HYDE VINEYARD – Carneros Pinot Noir:

“Tight, compact and concentrated, this is full-bodied and built around firm blackberry and wild berry fruit that’s framed by taut tannins. Needs time to unwind, but ends with a huckleberry note on the long, persistent finish.”
